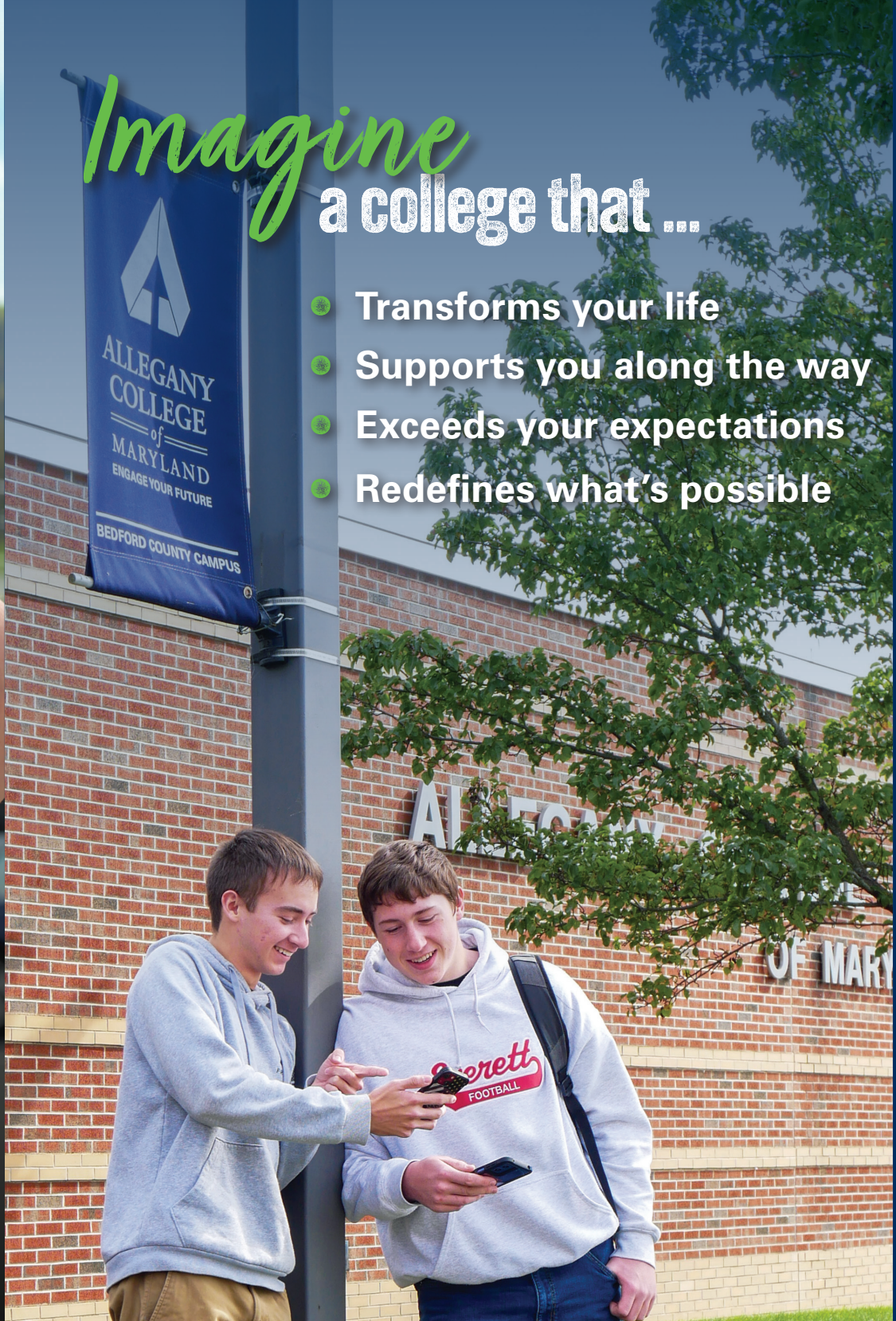

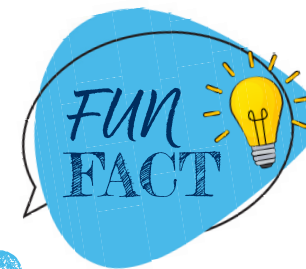

Making a life-changing investment in your future is simpler than you may think. ACM offers manageable tuition and payment plans. Students can take advantage of scholarship awards, financial aid, reduced tuition programs, and other assistance opportunities.

Students attending the Bedford County Campus may be eligible to receive tuition discounts:

Pennsylvania State Subsidy

\$100 off or more per credit hour by assistance received through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Financial Support for Early College Students
