

DRUGS / ALCOHOL/SMOKING

Allegany College of Maryland & WW is a clean, clear, and dry campus. Policies that apply to all persons on all College owned or managed property or while engaged in any College-sponsored or sanctioned activity:

- Tobacco Policy
- Alcohol & Drug Policy
- Heroin & Opioid Policy
- Employment Policies

- ✗ Smoking/Tobacco is prohibited.
 - » Includes vaping, e-cigarettes
- ✗ Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
 - » Regardless of your age.
 - » Unless authorized by the College President for specific purposes.
- ✗ Illegal drugs are prohibited anywhere on College property.
- ✗ Marijuana is prohibited (incl. marijuana legalized with restrictions under state law).
- ✗ No person may be impaired by any substance on College Property.
- ✗ Drug paraphernalia of any kind is prohibited in Willowbrook Woods.
 - » Including hookas, bongs, grinders, etc.
- ✗ Alcoholic beverage containers are prohibited in Willowbrook Woods.
 - » Regardless of purpose – including decoration.
 - » Bottles, cans, boxes, etc. will be confiscated and disposed.

- ✓ Violations will be handled under the Code of Student Conduct (credit students), Safety Risk Policy (non-credit students, visitors), ABE discipline policy, or HR policies (employees).
- ✓ If you are present where alcohol or drug activity is occurring, you can be held equally responsible. So if you see it happening, leave the area.
- ✓ Report any concerns you have about alcohol or drug activity **immediately**. You can report *anonymously* by calling Security at 301-784-5555.
- ✓ Impaired persons will be required to leave ACM property immediately.
If you drove to ACM, you will be required to arrange alternate transportation so you do not endanger yourself or others behind the wheel.
- ✓ Contraband will be confiscated.
- ✓ Willowbrook Woods Security may conduct car searches at the Willowbrook Woods Gatehouse with the approval of the Director of Campus Safety/Special Police and the Dean of Student & Legal Affairs -- or their authorized designees.
If a person refuses to permit the search, the vehicle will be denied entry.
