A2 (1/3) The idea of "guided pathways" is to help students get on their curricular pathway, ensure they are succeeding while taking classes in that program and ensuring they are successful, then to completing their degree & going into the workforce/transfer to a 4-year university

A2 (2/3) Every step of that pathway we have supports to assist the student and to ensure they stay on path and succeed. Student success means ACM has been successful. Sometimes students need help getting on the proper pathway for them. ACM website we have a "guided pathway"...
