TITLE IX PROCEDURE: REPORT FORM

SEXUAL HARASSMENT & SEX DISCRIMINATION POLICY

If you have experienced sexual harassment or sex discrimination, the College wants to know so we can take action to stop the behavior, prevent a recurrence, and remedy the effects. You can submit a *Report* that alerts the College and permits the consideration of multiple options to resolve the situation. Submitting this *Report* is one way to alert the College of potentially improper conduct that must be addressed. Be sure to review the policy and procedures online at https://www.allegany.edu/title-ix/index.html. A Report is NOT a Formal Complaint to request a formal grievance procedure which includes an investigation and a hearing.

NOTE: Other unlawful discrimination complaints are handled by a different (albeit similar) process.

(NOTE: This Report is not a private document if a formal investigation is begun; at that time, the Respondent will be given a copy of the complaint, attachments, future statements, and any other evidence.
