TITLE IX PROCEDURE: AMNESTY
SEX-BASED HARASSMENT & SEX DISCRIMINATION POLICY

Complainants, Respondents*, and witnesses shall not be subject to disciplinary action for drug/alcohol violations IF (a) the violation occurred during/near time of assault, (b) the assault report and participation in the investigation is in good faith, and (c) the violation was “not an act that was reasonably likely to place the health or safety of another individual at risk”.

* Per federal rules, all procedures must apply equally to Complainants and Respondents; per Maryland Law (HB571), Colleges must give amnesty to Complainants and witnesses. ACM satisfies both requirements by giving amnesty to all parties and witnesses.

Complainants, Respondents and witnesses may be referred for treatment as appropriate.
